

## Our Wedding - The Lowdown!

The invite has given you the key bits of information but here are a few other things that we wanted to share with you so that you are prepared and have a wonderful day celebrating with us.

### Location – Brook Farm, Cuffley, Herts, EN6 4EX

First things first, how do you get to our beautiful venue? The postcode; EN6 4EX will take you to the farmhouse, however, our wedding is not taking place there but down by the gorgeous lake. To get there, you need to turn in the gateway **opposite** the main farmyard. Your satnav will tell you to go into the farmyard but ignore that and go down the farm track opposite – it's just a green gateway with no buildings. After a few minutes' drive you will come to the lake and the parking area.

### Transport

**Cars:** Vehicles can be left overnight at the owners' risk & can be collected between 9am-1pm the next day.

**Train:** There are great links from Cuffley to London and Hertford. The site is located a 10-15 minute walk across arable fields from the station so although doable on a nice day, probably not great in heels. At the end of the night it will be pitch black so you will definitely need to get a taxi from the site to the station for your own safety.

**Taxis:** If you're planning on getting a taxi at the end of the night you will need to pre-book it. Ubers do not come down to collect from the site so you will need to pre-book a taxi with one of the friendly local taxi companies who know where the venue is and will happily drive down across the fields to collect you (numbers below). The bar will shut and everything will go off at midnight (or 11pm on Sundays) so please book your taxi for the end time.
